1. Old Testament and New Testament Survey

Systematic teaching to achieve an overview of the Bible. A survey of the Old Testament books with emphasis on their unity, special events, and relationship to the Bible as a whole.

5. Pastoral Theology. This subject centres around the ministerial life of a pastor: presenting the practical and ethical aspects of ministry along with an examination of pastoral responsibilities (5 sessions)

6. Ephesians 4 Ministries (10 sessions)

7. Church Government (5 sessions)

Teams, Administration, Elders, Deacons.

8. Gifts and Fruit of the Holy Spirit. A look at 1 Corinthians 12-14 and Galatians 5 (15 sessions)

9. General Discipleship. An in-depth examination of the basic truths, which should be taught to each new convert. Including: salvation, 3 baptisms, confession & repentance, servanthood, evangelism, knowing God's will, stewardship, prayer,

God's word, the Exchanged Life, and How to study the Bible. This class endeavours to take the student into areas of study which will enhance their daily experience with God (10 sessions).

10. Evangelism and Church Planting (10 sessions)
11. Praise and Worship (5 sessions)
12. Apologetics. A comparison of Christianity with other World Religions and so-called Christian Cults (5 sessions)
13. The Gospel of the Kingdom? (3 sessions)
14. Homiletics. This course will examine the practical methods of study, preparation, and presentation of the gospel. The main focus of the class will provide each student the opportunity to gain experience in presenting the word of God in a teaching/preaching format. (5 sessions)
15. Hermeneutics. An in-depth study of the rules of interpretation of the Bible (15 sessions)
16. Covenants. A study of the teaching on the importance of the Covenant relationship God has with His people (3 sessions)
17. Discipleship / Mentoring. An examination of the need for a life-long learning approach to ministry and how Jesus' methods can work today (3 sessions)
18. Spiritual Authority. A close look at the major areas of authority which we are to recognize and the balance between the use of and submission to authority in preparation for ministry (3 sessions)
19. Marriage & Family. An examination of the individual responsibilities and difficulties facing today's family. Particular emphasis will focus on the roles of husband, wife, and parents as we discover what makes a Christ-centred family (3 sessions)
20. Special Subjects that are areas of expertise of various teachers. Up to 50 sessions allocated. E.g.
 - Faith
 - School of Prophecy
 - Ministry to Youth & Children
 - Men & Women's Ministries
 - Youth & Children's Ministries
 - Prayer, intercession and spiritual warfare
 - Restoration
 - Apostolic / Prophetic leadership
